Advanced Study Program organized by Tokyo Institute of Technology, Japan

Announcement for students of member universities in Thailand, the Philippines, Singapore, Indonesia and Vietnam

- **OBJECTIVE**

To provide a joint study program for students from Tokyo Tech- AYSEAS member universities in Japan, Thailand, the Philippines, Singapore, Indonesia and Vietnam.

Participants can learn much from the dynamism of fast-growing Asia in industry, education and governance through discussion and communication with students from different backgrounds. Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS is the successor to the Japan-Asia Young Scientist and Engineer Study Visit (JAYSES) program, which ran from 2007 to 2012.

- **PROGRAM**

10-day study visit to Indonesia (**Jakarta and Bandung**)
(August 27 – September 5, 2019)

- (1) **Site Visits:** Participants will visit Indonesian and Japanese companies, government organizations, educational facilities, and research institutes, etc.
- (2) **Discussion:** The participants will separate into several groups to exchange opinions on selected topics.
- (3) **Presentation:** Each group will prepare a presentation after the discussion.

- **TOPICS for DISCUSSION**

Main theme: "From Asia to the World"

The discussion topics for Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS 2019 will be announced on the first day of the program.

Example of discussion topics from Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS 2018 in Vietnam:

- Cultural difference and understanding of different cultures
- Technology transfer between countries and the effect on business growth in each country
- Development of energy resources and protection of environment
- Motorization and traffic jams

- **HOW TO APPLY**

Email subject line must be "Application for AYSEAS 2019_(Your name)"

(2) The Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office will forward the application forms to the students' home universities for selection.

(3) The member universities nominate the successful applicants from their universities and send the results to the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office.

(4) After receiving nominations from member universities, the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office will send the acceptance notices to each successful candidate asking each accepted student to confirm his/her intention to join the program.

(5) The successful candidates should reply to the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office *within one week* of receiving the acceptance notice.

- **REQUIREMENTS**

(1) Applicants should have sufficient ability to communicate in written and spoken English.

(2) Students are expected to participate in all program activities held in Jakarta and Bandung. Therefore, students must be able to obtain an appropriate visa and be able to travel to Jakarta and Bandung.

- **EXPENSES**

Participating students are responsible for the cost of their:

(1) Airfare (Home → Jakarta → Home)

(2) Train fares (Jakarta → Bandung → Jakarta)

(3) Accommodation (including breakfast) and fieldtrip fees: approximately 400 USD

(4) Travel insurance

(5) Visa application fee(s)

(6) Personal expenses (meals, drinks, snacks, souvenirs, sightseeing etc.)
